Many of these children had a condition that the family was not aware of—a heart rhythm abnormality. These conditions that can lead to sudden cardiac death are entirely treatable though. And one of the top warning signs is unexplained fainting .	
As a local resident, I'm joining with the SADS Foundation (Sudden Arrhythmia Dea Syndromes Foundation) in their Fainting PSA campaign to help spread awareness about th common – but potentially deadly – warning sign.	

I'd like to share my first-hand experience with you on how increased awareness of these conditions can make an impact for families like mine. (Short story here. Tips: when referring to a child include the school or another local tie. For example: My son, John, a 3rd Grader at Arthur Williams Elementary School, has Long QT Type 1, so he takes a medication every day and receives regular care from a cardiologist. I'm so grateful for the diagnosis and care that he receives to keep him safe).
